CONSIDERATE PARKING

We have received a number of complaints from nearby neighbours regarding some parents who have been parking across driveways and congregating outside houses. May we please ask all parents and carers to be respectful to our nearby neighbours as we have very close links to our local community and would like to ensure we uphold our good reputation. We thank you for your co-operation.

Please see below an email received from the South Gloucestershire Council Anti-social Behaviour Case Officer;

"The message is aimed primarily at those who meet and greet in the Creswicke Avenue location and the request is for them to not;

Leave litter on the walls or in the gardens of residents. Please take all litter with them. There have been reports of tin cans, smoking debris, food containers etc being left behind and stuffed into bushes in people gardens. Not to use any abusive language – this has not been aimed at any resident but is used within parents who cluster together and is therefore overheard by residents. This kind of language is clearly unacceptable when young children are present.

Not to block the driveways or pedestrian gates of houses – one resident returned home from the local shops to find a man stood on her front path, inside the gateway who refused to move when asked despite being told that the lady lived at the address.

To restrict the amount of time they spend dropping off/collecting children to minimise the impact on residents in that street. There have been reports of parents arriving shortly after 8am and then staying in situ talking amongst themselves until 10am before leaving."
