### Sports Premium Spending 2015-16

#### What is Sports Premium Funding?

This is targeted money provided by the government to develop sport and physical activity in schools. We welcome this funding and we are using it to provide high quality PE and physical opportunities in school.

#### Sport and Physical Education

Sport and Physical exercise play a big part in the life of our school. It is an important part of the school curriculum and a key part of the school's extra-curricular programme. The school promotes sport to keep children active and healthy, foster teamwork, provide opportunities for fair competition, support physical and emotional development and to have fun.

The Sports Premium Funding has been used to develop the teaching of PE in the school curriculum, offer extra-curricular activity and to develop opportunities for inter and intra school competition.
